RIDE CLASSIFICATIONS

To better anticipate the type of riding to be expected, we classify our rides into three categories.

- A** Brisk pace, pacelines likely, regroupes every 30/60 min, with a 10 min. wait, usual speed 18-20+ mph average.
- B** Touring pace with pacelines possible, regroupes every 30/45 min. waiting for all riders to assemble. Usual speeds are 15-18 mph average.
- C** Relaxed pace with no pacelines and frequent regroupes. Usual speeds are 12-15 mph average.
